I. R-01 Richard W. Merritt, D.C.

Richard W. Merritt, D.C. was not present on the conference call, and was not represented by Counsel.

Mr. Dierlam presented case number 2011-12719 as a reconsideration of the original Administrative Complaint. At a previous meeting of the Probable Cause Panel, the Panel dismissed 1 count of the original Administrative Complaint, leaving only the count pertaining to recordkeeping. The department then requested that the remaining count be dismissed as well.

Dr. LaRusso was not in favor of dismissal, stating that he believed a Letter of Guidance would be more appropriate. Dr. Fox agreed.

Mr. Dierlam stated that a Letter of Guidance was no longer an option. Ms. Loucks stated that the case has already been reviewed by all 3 Probable Cause Panels; therefore, there may be issues with quorum should the case be presented to the Full Board for action.

Board action: Motion to dismiss was made by Dr. Fox and seconded by Dr. LaRusso.
